So much wrong information about sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) gets passed around that it's no surprise that diseases do too.

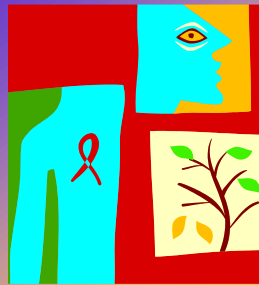
- ◇ Of course, the only way to be 100% sure you won't get an STD like herpes, chlamydia, or HIV, is not to have any type of sex (abstinence).
