Pine Manor Community Center "Local Safe Place"

Pine Manor Community Center partners with Lutheran Services and provides Safe Place to reach youth in the early stage of crisis. Young people are provided with non-threatening place.

This is a community initiative to educated young people about the dangers of trying to resolve difficult, threatening situations on their own. It is estimated that over two million young people run away each year, on the streets these youth are at risk, more likely to commit suicide, become victims of crimes or perpetrate crimes. Increasing numbers of kids are also being put of their homes by disinterested, frustrated or abusive parents.

History:

Developed in the 60's as it was conveniently located to the town of Fort Myers. People were attracted to Pine Manor, with reasonable housing, neighborhoods began developing around a sense of community.

Today:
